THE CHAIRMAN'S AWARD

The Chairman's Award has been established by the AISA for the specific purpose of recognizing member schools that achieve athletic excellence during the school year. This award will also serve as a symbol of recognition to the individuals who have unselfishly given of their time to serve as chairperson of the AISA State Athletic Committee.

Those schools will be honored annually with a rotating plaque. One school will be selected from each of the three classifications in the AISA basketball program.

POINT SYSTEM

- I. Interscholastic sports program:
 - A. 10 Points will be awarded for each team sport sponsored by the school with a regular season schedule of at least five (5) contests. Note: In the case of track, tennis, and golf only five (5) points will be earned if a full team is not sponsored. In track, the minimum is one qualifying meet and the AISA State Track Meet.
 - B. 20 Points will be awarded for team entry into state play-off or tournament. Note: In the case of track, tennis, volleyball and golf no points will be awarded if more than half the positions or events are not filled.
 - C. State Play-offs or Tournament Finish (Team Sports) Football, Boys and Girls Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Cheerleading, Boys and Girls Tennis, Volleyball, Golf, Boys and Girls Track, Soccer)
 - 50 Points for team championship
 - 40 Points for team runner-up
 - 30 Points for third place team
 - 20 Points for fourth place team
 - D. All Star Selection - 10 Points will be awarded for each All Star selected in football, basketball, volleyball, baseball, softball and cheerleading (*seniors only*). (Maximum of 4 All-Stars per category)
- II. Athletic Scholarship - Current senior class (**AISA office must have a copy and/or documentation of scholarship.**)
 - 15 Points for each scholarship received
- III. Student-Athlete Award:
 - 10 Points for each student-athlete award winner
- IV. Eligibility:
 - 25 Points for having eligibility into the AISA on time and completely cleared by

the AISA.

V. Sportsmanship:

25 Points if no unsportsmanlike and/or unprofessional actions write-ups are received involving your school during the current year. *Ejections for coaches and players are included.*

VI. Tie Breakers:

The following tie breakers are to be implemented in order of listing:

- A. Points earned in Item V
- B. Points earned in Item IV
- C. Points earned in I-C
- D. Pints earned in I-A and B of the President's Award Criteria.
